Federal NSGP

The Nonprofit Security Grant Program is designed specifically to help secure nonprofits against potential threats through facility hardening and improved security operations.



State-Level Security Grants

Supplemental programs (such as CSNSGP in California and SCAHC in New York) offer distinct, parallel funding pools to maximize your community's defense.

Potential Grant Funding Limits

**Note: Examples only; limits vary by program cycle and state. State security funds are subject to availability.*

Program	Funding Limit
Federal NSGP	Up to \$200,000 per physical site/address
California CSNSGP	Up to \$250,000 per location
New York SCAHC	Up to \$250,000 per eligible organization
Colorado State	State security funds subject to availability

Translating Funding into Physical Security

Facility Hardening

Bulletproof doors, reinforced windows, and structural reinforcements.

Security Personnel

Funding for contracted security professionals to monitor access.

Surveillance Systems

High-definition cameras and monitoring equipment.

Access Control

Electronic locks, alarms, and emergency notification systems.



The Administrative Reality

Grant funding is highly competitive and cannot be guaranteed. Winning requires accuracy, compliance, organization, and a highly competitive application.

Understanding the Reimbursement Model

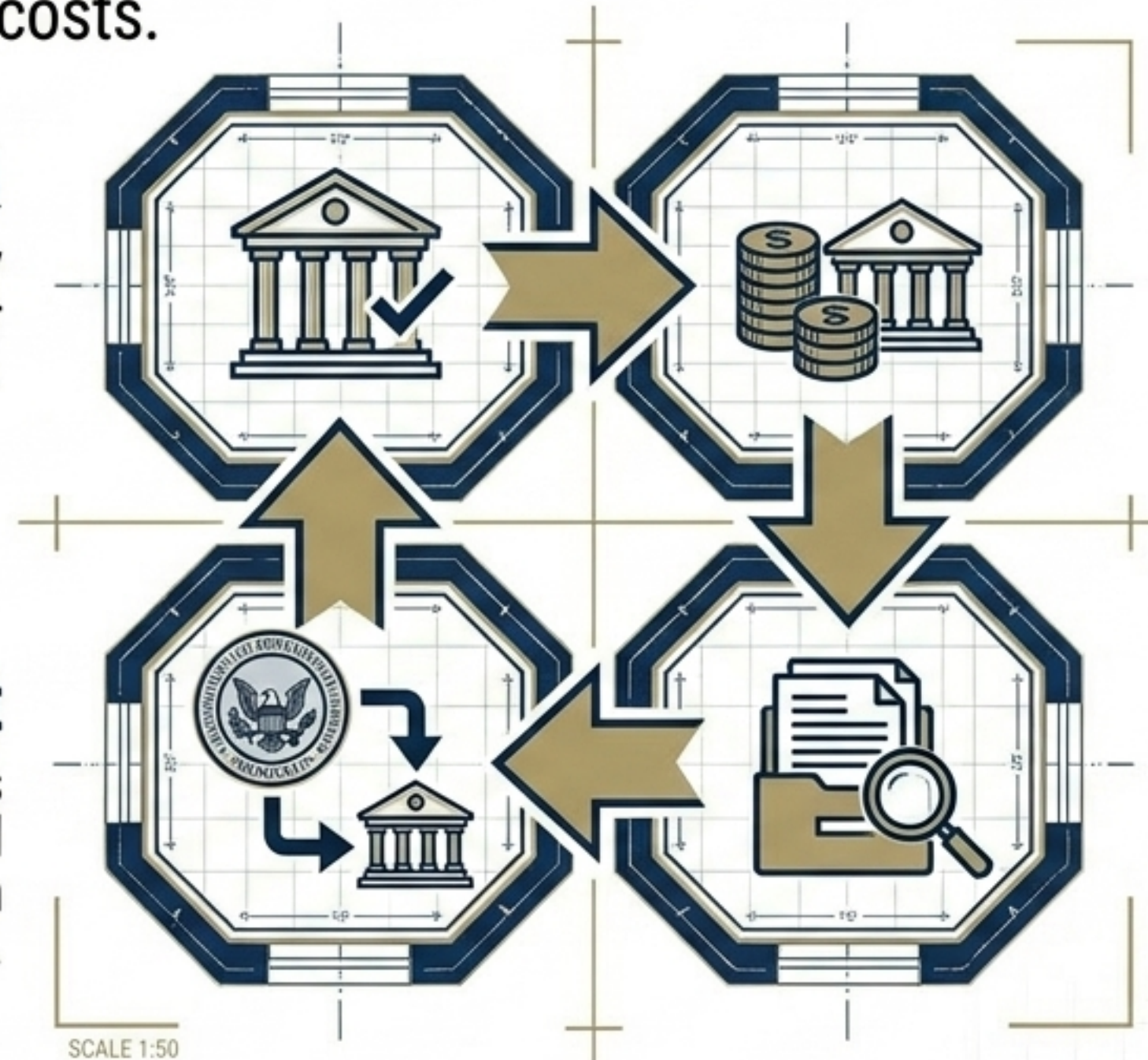
Important: Many security grants do not provide upfront cash. **Precise documentation** is required to recover your costs.

Project Approval

The grant is officially awarded based on your compliant application.

Reimbursement

The government reviews the documentation and reimburses your organization for the approved costs.



Upfront Payment

Your organization pays for the approved security vendors and physical project costs first.

Rigorous Documentation

Every receipt, invoice, and proof of payment is meticulously logged to state/federal standards.
